Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park is a motor sports venue located very close to our dealership. A map of the location with relation to this facility is available in this packet along with other restaurants and attractions.

The facility opened as Firebird International Raceway in 1983 and hosts the NHRA's Arizona Nationals. Now named the Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park, it is an extremely popular venue for location and national motor sports enthusiasts. For 32 years, Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park has been a true staple and contributor to Arizona sports history. The likes of such legends as Andretti, Garlits, Senna and Muldowney are only a handful of the countless internationally renowned names that have made the facility a true lexicon for speed and competition.



Year-round, motorsports fans flock to the 600 acre multi-use facility to witness unleashed and unbridled raw horsepower, from 300-mph nitro burning dragsters, to monster trucks, off-road races, drag boats and everything in between. Some of the biggest brands in motorsports, including Lucas Oil, Coca-Cola, CARQUEST and Ford find the park to be the ideal facility to springboard their regional marketing programs.

The park includes four race tracks: a 1/4 mile NHRA sanctioned drag strip; 1.6 mile road course; a 10-turn 1.25 mile road course; and a 1.1 mile road course, incorporating 11 tight turns and a 3/8 mile straight-away. It also features a 2.4 mile IHBA and APBA sanctioned oval lake.

With Wild Horse Pass Motorsports Park's ever-growing offerings, it's the perfect venue for almost any event motorsports or non-motorsports, providing exhilarating experiences and unique memories to last a lifetime.
